Oral Presentation Guide

Speakers in oral sessions will have 12 minutes for presentation and 3 minutes for Q&A, totally 15 minutes. A screen, an LCD projector and a laptop computer are provided in each session room. Speakers can bring their USBs which include the presentation files. If speakers want to bring their own laptops, they can connect the laptops to the LCD projector with either a regular RGB cable or an HDMI cable. If speakers bring laptops requiring any conversion adapter to be connected to the LCD projector, please do not forget to bring it with you.

Poster Presentation Guide

Poster boards are in vertical format, please prepare a standard A0 size poster (841 mm width × 1189 mm height), or sheets which can be assembled to be that size or smaller.

The general display time is 08:30–18:00. Presenters are kindly asked to put up their posters on the day the specific poster session is scheduled as soon as possible (08:30–09:40, but not in the evening before the scheduled display day) in order to enable the conference participants to view their posters at any time on the display day. Presenters are then asked to take down their posters between 18:10 and 20:00. After this time, the remaining posters will be disposed of by the conference staff and they will not be stored.

The presenters in attendance time is the time when the respective presenters of a poster session must be present at their display for presentation. The presenters in attendance time of each poster session is given in the programme.

Place the title of your paper clearly at the top of the poster to allow viewers to easily identify your paper. Indicate the presenters' names and address information in order to allow interested viewers to contact you for more information.

Prepare all diagrams or charts neatly and legibly beforehand, in a size sufficient to be read at a distance of 1.5–2.0 meters.
